The parties to this agreement share the mutual goals of restoring pastures and grasslands to improve water quality and wildlife habitat. The purpose of this agreement is to assist landowners and land managers in restoring critical habitats.

Possession of the Truax Drill FLXII-812, serial number 879 has been formally conveyed to the User for the Stated Period of Use with the following stipulations in place:

The landowner agrees to (Landowner checks to confirm):

- Use the drill according to a managed grazing plan, forest stewardship plan, CRP contract, or Partners for Fish and Wildlife agreement.
- Assume responsibility for damage that occurs during operation of the drill.
- Perform daily maintenance activities according to the no-till user guide.
- Entirely clean the drill of leftover seed and debris that has occurred from use.
- Return the drill to the trailer for pick-up by the agreed-upon date and time.
- Store the drill in a building or under a tarp if loaned for an extended period of time.

Southwest Badger RC&D agrees to (Project Officer checks to confirm):

- Work with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service to make arrangements for the transportation of the drill to and from the landowner and general drill maintenance.
- Provide instructions on the operation and daily drill maintenance.
- Refund the user's deposit after inspection and pick-up of the drill is complete and any service or repair caused by the user has been performed.
