Terms of Use

The parties to this agreement share the mutual goals of restoring pastures and grasslands to improve water quality and wildlife habitat. The purpose of this agreement is to assist landowners and land managers in restoring critical habitats.

Possession of the equipment has been formally conveyed to the User for the Stated Period of Use with the following stipulations in place:

The landowner agrees to:

1. Use the equipment according to a managed grazing plan, a forest stewardship plan, or a Partners for Fish and Wildlife agreement.
2. Store the equipment in a building or under a tarp if loaned for an extended period of time.
3. Assume responsibility for damage that occurs during operation of equipment.
4. Return the equipment on the designated date and time unless other arrangements are made.
5. Perform daily maintenance activities according to the equipment operator manual.
6. Entirely clean drill of leftover seed and debris that has occurred from use.

Southwest Badger RC&D agrees to:

1. Work with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service to make arrangements for the transportation of the drill to the landowner.
2. Provide instruction on the operation and maintenance of the drill.
